NOTE: This Special Called Meeting of the Wise County Commissioners Court is for the sole purpose of the Wise County Commissioners Court to enter into discussion with possible action to be taken in regards to a proposed property tax rate levy in this 2010 Year and for the FY 2011 Budget Year, all for the Wise County Weatherford College Branch Campus Maintenance Tax , and also being in conjunction with the August 1, 2010 tax information publication in the Wise County Messenger as calculated and being provided by Wise County Tax Assessor-Collector, Mr. Monte Shaw.

Should the proposed tax rate chosen during this Special Called Meeting exceed the published rollback rate or the effective tax rate (whichever is lower), then the Commissioners Court members will take a record vote and schedule public hearing(s) in accordance with the Texas Property Tax Code and the Truth-In-Taxation requirements. However, in the event the proposed tax rate discussed during said Special Meeting is voted to be equal to or lower than the August 1, 2010 published effective tax rate, then no further public meetings or notice, in regards to the 2010 property tax levy, is required, and said proposed equal or lower effective tax rate shall be adopted as a Resolution Order in a near future public meeting, following the separate Adoption Order of the FY 2011 Wise County Weatherford College Branch Campus Maintenance and Operations Budget.
