There is a 3-minute time limit, and large groups interested in the same topic should select a spokesperson. 10. Consider and Discuss Bridge Abutment Failure Policy on soil able backfields. Take necessary action. (CD)
11. Consider and Discuss Adoption of the Wise County Local Mitigation Plan, DR1931-004. Take necessary action. (JDC) (CB)
12. Discuss authorizing County Judge J.D. Clark to nominate Wise County as the site of the 2016 NACo Rural Action Caucus Fall Symposium. Take any necessary action. (JDC)
