
Memorandum of Understanding for Weapons Supplied to the North Texas Honor Guard by the Secretary of the Army.

The Wise County Sheriff's Department has agreed to be the storage facility for **M1 Rifles (15)**. This agreement is in accordance with law **Title 10 USC 4683 and Title 18 USC 922(d)**. The North Texas Honor Guard will maintain all upkeep on the weapons.


The weapons are to be checked out by Commander Bobby W. Harris **ONLY**. Officer elections for the North Texas Honor Guard are held each February and officers may change. The sheriff's office will be informed of any changes in writing. A check out/in sheet will be signed and dated each time weapons are taken, listing the number of weapons and will be maintained by the sheriff's designee.

In accordance with **Title 10 USC 4683 #4** the North Texas Honor Guard agrees not to use the rifles, under any circumstances, as security for any loan, nor sell, lease, rent, exchange the property for monetary gain or other use. The North Texas Honor Guard further agrees that the rifles should not be transferred, **loaned to another organization**, or otherwise disposed of without the written consent of the Secretary of the Army. If disposition is attempted by any method (including re-donation) without the consent of the Secretary of the Army, this agreement will be terminated and the ceremonial rifles shall be repossessed by the Secretary of the Army.






Dear Mrs. Eva Rodgers,
