


1. Call Court to Order. (JDC)

Community Forum *(The Commissioners Court invites persons with comments or observations related to County issues, projects, and policies to briefly address the Court for the limited purpose of determining whether the matter should be referred to staff for study and response and/or be placed on a future meeting. Anyone speaking during the Community Forum should first identify themselves by their first and last names for the public record. There is a 3-minute time limit, and large groups interested in the same topic should select a spokesperson. State law prohibits the Court from deliberating on any item not listed on the posted agenda.)* (JDC)

6. Consider approval of Minutes of Commissioners Court Meeting of Monday, January 12, 2015. Take necessary action. (SL) (JDC)
7. Presentation from 911 Operations to recognize a Wise County SO Telecommunicator. (Kelly Williams)
8. Consider and act on resolution in opposition to unfunded mandates. (JDC)
9. Consider and act on resolution to indigent health care mandatory assessment. (JDC)
10. Consider and act on resolution in opposition to removing County fireworks regulation authority. (JDC) (KB)
11. Consider and act on resolution in support of designating the Chisholm Trail and the Great Western Trail as National Historic Trails. (JDC)
12. Discuss resolution in support of voter choice for Wise County Water Control and Improvement District. Take action if necessary. (JDC) (KB)
