**WISE COUNTY RESOLUTION IN OPPOSITION TO INDIGENT HEALTH CARE
MANDATORY ASSESSMENT**

WHEREAS, revisions have been proposed regarding the Texas system of indigent health care;
and

WHEREAS, some revisions propose an assessment upon counties to support a regional indigent
health care system; and

WHEREAS, such assessment would constitute an unfunded mandate, requiring property tax
increases in those counties; and


WHEREAS, such regional systems would not be efficient or responsive to local taxpayers;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Commissioners Court of Wise County, Texas,
opposes any attempt to impose a mandatory assessment upon Texas counties to fund a

of the Wise County Commissioners Court.








