WISE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS' COURT MEETING

On this the 14th day of September, A.D., 2015 at 8:30 A.M. came on to be had a Public Hearing of the Commissioners' Court of Wise County, Texas held in the County Court at Law Jury Room (3rd) Floor in County Courthouse of said County in the town of Decatur with the following members present and presiding:

Sherry Lemon, County Clerk and Ex-Officio Clerk of Commissioners' Court when and where the following proceedings were had, to-wit:

All attachments referred to in the minutes of the Wise County Commissioners' Court are designated original or copy and are provided at the time of action by the Court unless otherwise indicated by provider.

County Judge Clark votes aye on all agenda items unless otherwise indicated.

Clark stated the purpose of the public hearing is to receive comments regarding adoption of a County Clerk Archive Fee (\$10.00) for the preservation of records held by the County Clerk.

Lemon invited court members to come to the office to look at the way the records are kept by the County Clerk's office. Lemon stated her office is progressive in taking care of the records held at the County Clerk's office and stated "we hold people's lives."

Lemon stated this is not a new fee and is a continuation of a fee that began in last year's budget and requires public hearing before approval. Lemon told the court that she presented a Records Management Plan to the court prior to the hearing that outlines records kept in the County Clerk's Office. Lemon stated there are some exceptions to the archiving requirement (some correspondence and some applications). Lemon stated that she doesn't think the county clerk's office will ever be completely paperless.



No comments were made.


Clark closed the public hearing at 8:45 AM there being no further discussion.

Kevin Burns, Commr. Pct. No. 2


