

APPLICATION FOR PIPELINE UTILITY PERMIT
DESIGNATING PLACEMENT OF UTILITY IN COUNTY RIGHT OF WAY

TO: THE COUNTY ENGINEER OF WISE COUNTY, TEXAS

Comes now West Wise Special Utility District [company name], hereinafter referred to as "Company" a District [state] Corporation, with authority to transact business in Texas, acting by and through its duly authorized representative, and hereby petitions the County Engineer for the right to lay, construct, maintain, repair and/or operate equipment under, over, across and/or along certain County Roads as shown on drawings and diagrams attached hereto and said location described as follows:

The location and description of the proposed installation and appurtenances must be fully shown on the attached detailed drawings.

The Company shall commence actual construction/work in good faith within 60 days from the date of said permit and shall complete said construction /work within 15 working days. (COMPANY MUST FILL IN). If such construction is not begun by the 60th day, Company will be required to apply for a new permit.

Company declares that prior to filing this application, it has ascertained the location of all existing utilities, both aerial and underground, and the filing of this application is prima facie evidence that the proposed installation will not conflict with any existing utility.

A copy of this permit shall be kept at the job site any time work is being performed.

It is expressly stipulated that this Permit is a license for permissive use only and that the placing of facilities upon public property pursuant to this permit shall not operate to create or vest any property right in said holder.

It is understood and agreed that the rights and privileges herein set out are granted only to the extent of the County's right, title and interest in the land to be entered upon and used by the holder and the holder will at all times assume risk of and indemnify, defend and save harmless Wise County from and against any and all loss, damages, cost or expense

arising in any manner on account of the exercise or attempted exercise by said holder of the aforesaid rights and privileges.

Any deviation from these specifications must be approved by Wise County Engineer's Office or its designated representative.

Approval of County Engineer's Office may take as long as two weeks after complete application is received.

Applicant agrees to comply with all rules of the County Commissioners and the County Engineer in construction of said installation attached hereto as **WISE COUNTY DESIGN STANDARDS AND SAFETY PRECAUTION REQUIREMENTS FOR WORK CONDUCTED IN WISE COUNTY RIGHTS OF WAY** and incorporated herein for reference.

In the event Company fails to obtain a permit prior to the installation or does not install utilities in compliance with installation requirements set forth herein (i.e. depth, location, etc), Company assumes all financial responsibility for damages and/or destruction of lines, cables, etc. based upon its failure to comply with Wise County requirements.


Applicant agrees that if Wise County demonstrates a violation of the terms of this policy, Applicant stipulates that requisites for injunctive relief exist and that Wise County is entitled to relief enjoining any conduct by applicant which is contrary to the policies.

This permit is a revocable permit. Wise County reserves the right to revoke this permit at any time, in the sole discretion of Wise County, for interests of public health, safety or welfare, or for failure to repair any damages upon demand, or for any other reason deemed sufficient by Wise County.

In the event Company fails to comply with any or all of the requirements as set forth herein, the County may take such action as it deems appropriate to compel compliance. The County Engineer further retains the right to revoke this Permit by verbal notification to the Applicant/Company.

Failure to obtain this permit and/or notify the County Engineer's Office within 24 hours of beginning construction shall constitute grounds for job shutdown.





ORDER GRANTING PERMIT AND RIGHT-OF WAY
TO CONSTRUCT WATER PIPELINE

THE COUNTY OF WISE

Now on this 14 day of September, 2015 at a meeting of the

Commissioners Court of Wise County, Texas, came on to be considered the application of

West Wise Special Utility District for a permit and

right-of-way to lay water pipeline under the public roads of the County of Wise, State of

Texas, and the Court having considered such application which was filed on the

14 day of September, 2015 and is referred to and made a part hereof, and

having determined that the permit an right-of-way for such water pipeline should be granted, it is accordingly ordered by the court:

1. That the County of Wise, State of Texas, does hereby grant the right, privilege and right-of-way to West Wise Special Utility District to lay, construct, maintain, and operate a water pipeline under the public roads in the County of Wise, State of Texas, as described:

Description and Location: 404 CR 3225

See plans for more detail.

2. That such waterline opening shall be bored, constructed and maintained as not to interfere with the use and occupancy of such public roads by the public. That such waterline shall be buried to the depth of minimum 36" (3' feet) below the lowest point of surface. Install visible marking of the crossing.
3. Said pipeline right-of-way shall be marked with pipeline marker signs at road right-of-way fence lines.
